



2017 Rule Amendments

Bandoleros

Maximum age for competition is 16 years old. Drivers who turn 17 years old during the season will **not** be allowed to compete once they turn 17 years old.

Women On Wheels

TRANSMISSIONS

Only automatic transmissions allowed

CLOTHING

Long sleeves and pants are mandatory

Mini Stock

SAFETY

Gloves and racing shoes/boots are recommended.

ENGINE, DRIVE TRAIN and COMPONENTS

(As stated in previous years) Engine, transmission (automatic or standard), and rear end must remain stock. No interchanging parts. Motor is to be stock for make and model of car. If running automatic transmission, must run automatic throttle body. If running standard transmission, must run standard throttle body.

There will be a sealing process to the engines by Petty International Raceway (PIR).

PIR will randomly be selecting cars from race to race and installing stock computers which are sealed.

TIRES and WHEELS

All wheels must be either 185/60 or 65 12" to 195/60 or 65 15" diameter. All tires must be DOT approved.

No V rated tires. All tires must be DOT approved.

No Legend tires allowed.

Street Stock

FIREWALL/FOOT BOX

Foot box measurement from the center of the top bolt on the steering box closest to the top control arm to the front of the foot box, maximum 35 inches.

Foot box must be built with 1/8" steel plate.

Brake pedals must be hanging and master cylinder must be bolted directly to foot box.

BATTERIES

Batteries must be on right side of the car, under the hood as close to the windshield as possible.

FLOOR

Floor must be built 1/8' steel plate front to rear.

INTERIOR

All interior must be minimum of 22 gauge steel no aluminum anywhere.

WEIGHT

Non stock firewalls must carry 50lbs on top of foot box.

If floor is not stock must run an additional 50lbs: example 3400 + 50.

REAR SPRING CUPS

Must be stock.

WHEEL BASE

Cars with wheel base shortened must run 25lbs per inch to minimum of 108 inches measured from the center of the ball joint to the center of the rear end housing. Competitors must tell Petty Tech what frame you are running to determine what the wheel base length should be.

BODIES

All body panels must be steel with the exception of the hood and front and rear cover. The hood and front and rear cover may fibreglass or plastic.

FUEL CELL

Fuel cell must be a minimum of 12" from the ground to the bottom of the cell, not the bracket.

TIRES

Still under review. Will advise as soon as possible.

Limited Late Models

The only change for 2017 will be tires. The new tire rule is:

Used 1070 Hoosiers supplied by Petty International Raceway. Day One teams will be allowed to purchase 8 tires at a cost of \$50 per tire. Teams will be allowed up to 4 tires for each following race event. Tires will be impounded. A maximum of 8 tires per team will be held in impounded inventory.
